

2006 BANQUET PRESENTATION OF CERTIFICATES FOR ROSA E. FIOAL MEMBERSHIP AWARDS

During the 2005-2006 year, District 11 members have been building strong clubs through the recruitment and retention of members in Zonta International. Some clubs' efforts at recruitment and retention warrant special recognition. The membership of District 11 has been blessed with an annual gift from the Rosa E. Fiol Trust. In keeping with Dr. Fiol's wishes, District 11 has established a membership award to be given to the club in each area that has the greatest percentage increase in net membership. Newly organized clubs also receive a membership award.

Each winner of the Rosa E. Fiol Membership Award receives a trophy to be kept for the remainder of the club year, along with a certificate of recognition for the club's records. Last, but not least, each winning club and the clubs of Puerto Rico, Caguas, Ponce, and San Juan, receive a \$200 credit for conference attendance.

The Zonta Club of Mobile increased its membership by a net of 12 members for a 70% increase.

The Zonta Club of Bluffton increased its membership by a net of 11 members, for a 61% increase.

The Zonta Club of Greater Miami increased its membership by a net of 2 members for a 22% increase.

The Zonta Club of Tampa increased its membership by a net of 4, for a 28% increase.

Area 5

The Zonta Club of San Juan increased its membership by a net of 5 members for a 29% increase.

The Zonta Club of Bonita Springs increased its membership by a net of 12 members for a 66% increase.

And the newest club organized in District 11, the Zonta Club of Ocala in Area 4 which was chartered with 31 members.
